Normally the Shields-Trauger Memorial Award is presented at Fiesta in October. But since Bill doesn't usually attend Fiesta, the BFA Board of Directors made a special exception to present the award early to Bill at the Derby festival in front of his family and friends. North Central director and BFA Secretary Tim Cloyd transported Bill's framed certificate over 2,000 miles on a long distance adventure before arriving in Kentucky. BFA President Dean Carlton presented the Shields-Trauger Memorial Award to Bill Smith, who received a standing ovation from his peers, family members, and teammates.

Bill remarked that even though this was a solo flight, it took an entire team of people to make it happen. He thanked all involved in this great accomplishment.



Board of Directors meet in Shreveport

On Saturday, April 22, 2017 the Balloon Federation of America held its Spring face to face board meeting in Shreveport, Louisiana. All the members of the board were there in person with the exception of Northeast Director David Tanzer who joined the meeting via Skype.

It was a long but productive day, starting at 8:00am and ending after 6:00pm with a working lunch. The meeting opened with routine activities such as the approval of the prior minutes and our monthly financial report. Treasurer Maury Sullivan reports that the financial condition of the organization is quite good.

Membership Chair Cheri White led a good discussion regarding membership. Several good ideas were presented such as expanding the social media reach, increased communications to balloon clubs, development of a BFA "App", crew outreach, possible awards for younger members, and more. Look to see a survey related to membership in the coming weeks.

Maury Sullivan led a review and update of the Board Policies and Procedures manual. This document had not been updated in many years, and needed quite a bit of refinement.

Long Jump Chair Tim Cloyd updated the group on the 2017 Long Jump season. Kent Barnes joined us electronically to discuss updating the BFA Instructor Program. We had reports from the Hot Air Competition Division, the Gas Division, and the PRO Division.

Mike Shrum joined us and provided information on the Junior Balloonist Program, specifically updates on the 3 summer camps for 2017 (Albuquerque, Reno, and Oshkosh). The Albuquerque camp is full, but there are still spots available in the other camps for now.

Dean Carlton gave a report on the 2017 BFA Online Webinar. He indicated that we had significant technological difficulties, but most registrants were able to complete the course via video. He stated that a new idea for the 2018 webinar is under development that would reduce the tech risk. Nearly 400 people attended the online seminar.

Katie Griggs reported on the progress of the 2018 FAVIA 225/BFA Convention scheduled for next March in Philadelphia. She also indicated that she was finishing a request for proposal document to be used to find a 2021 convention location.

The group was also updated on progress with the BFA interaction with the FAASTeam, the Safety Education committee, and the election process for this summer. Glen Moyer gave an update on the status of the Journal publications, and indicated he has several good stories in the pipeline for future issues.

A special treat of the day was meeting a young lady named Emilie, who has a parent that works for Louisiana State University Shreveport (the host location for the 2017 US Nationals). She shared with us some

health challenges she has, and how by being strong she is making great process toward her recovery. She is very excited to see balloons in her town this July, and now has some 'balloon bling' to use during that week.

Our local hosts made us feel very welcome. A big "Thank You" goes out to our Friday night hosts Phillip, Angie, and Michael Gullo of Gullo's Market in Bossier City, and our Saturday night hosts Kelly Wells, Ken Wojcik, and Pat and Susan Harwell who made sure we ate very well this weekend. And kudos to "Ballooning" magazine editor and Shreveport local Glen Moyer who helped make our visit in his town a memorable one.


