Board votes to join opposition to ATC privitization

At it's July meeting the Board of Directors of the Balloon Federation of America voted to join other aviationrelated groups in opposition in a proposed plan to privatize the Air

Traffic Control System (ATC).



In part, the statement by these groups reads: "After a thoroughand detailed review of Chairman

Bill Shuster's (R-PA) proposal, HR 2997, the AIRR Act of 2017, which would remove our nation's air traffic control operations from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), we have concluded that these reforms will produce uncertainty and unintended consequences without achieving the desired outcomes."

Additionally the statement reads: "We have concluded that any structural and governance reforms that requireprotections for an important sector of users is fundamentally flawed.

In addition, the billions of dollars and time that would be spent transitioning our nation's air traffic control system to a not-for-profit entity can be better applied to the continuing progress to update and modernize our air traffic control system – including meeting the FAA's mandate to equip the general aviation fleet with see and- avoid (ADSB) technology by 2020.

Moreover, with strong bipartisan opposition in both the House and Senate to remove air traffic control operations from the FAA, we believe efforts should focus on developing a long-term FAA Reauthorization that creates the stability and funding necessary and that can reach the President's desk for signature."


