

Bill Smith's High Altitude Flight



After more than 6 months of preparation pilot Bill Smith of Louisville, KY completed a flight to nearly 32,000 ft. on Saturday June 16. Bill flew his brand new Lindstrand 105 named Phantom during a perfectly executed high altitude flight. The weather conditions were perfect, there wasn't a cloud in the sky and Bill actually covered more vertical distance (6 miles up, 6 miles down) than he did horizontally, landing less than 7 miles from where he took off! For this flight Bill was equipped with a transponder, specially modified burners, oxygen and cold weather gear as the ambient air was below zero when he reached his maximum altitude.

Bill is a very accomplished pilot. Within the last 2 years he has completed a duration flight of 12 hours, a distance flight of approximately 750 miles and now a high altitude flight to more than 31,000 feet. These feats are the result of Bill's constant tinkering, tireless planning, and awesome sense of adventure.

EAA, BALLOON FEDERATION OF AMERICA ANNOUNCE JOINT EFFORT TO BOOST AVIATION PARTICIPATION Agreement updates joint efforts to introduce and support flying on all levels

"The BFA and its members are excited to explore a closer partnership with the EAA and begin work on how both organizations will, in a mutual way, promote and increase aviation participation across all age groups," said Cheri White, BFA President. "We share so many fundamental principles that working together will benefit all our members and recreational aviation overall. We're excited to build a close relationship with our friends within EAA."

EAA and BFA will create a joint working group to further explore possibilities for joint activities and programs that could inspire youth and adults to further explore ways to get involved in model aviation or recreational flying. Communicate the Presence of Power Lines!





In a continued effort to improve safety in ballooning, the BFA is implementing a new initiative to implement at the landing phase of flight. This new ground crew communication gesture will be universally recognized by pilots of other types of aircraft as it fits into the FAA, Navy, ICAO-'Int'I-AIM' use of hand signals for reference and communication.

Alert pilots of a hidden powerlines using the new hand signaling procedure. The arm bent over the top of one's head will now be recognized as the universal indicator of a power/phone line. The other arm is used to get the pilot's attention and to point to the hazard. The pilot could even communicate back with the same gesture to crew that the warning was received. Please spread the word on this new safety initiative as it could no doubt prevent an accident in our ballooning community. Thanks to Mike Hance who first brought this idea to the BFA and balloon events in Texas.
